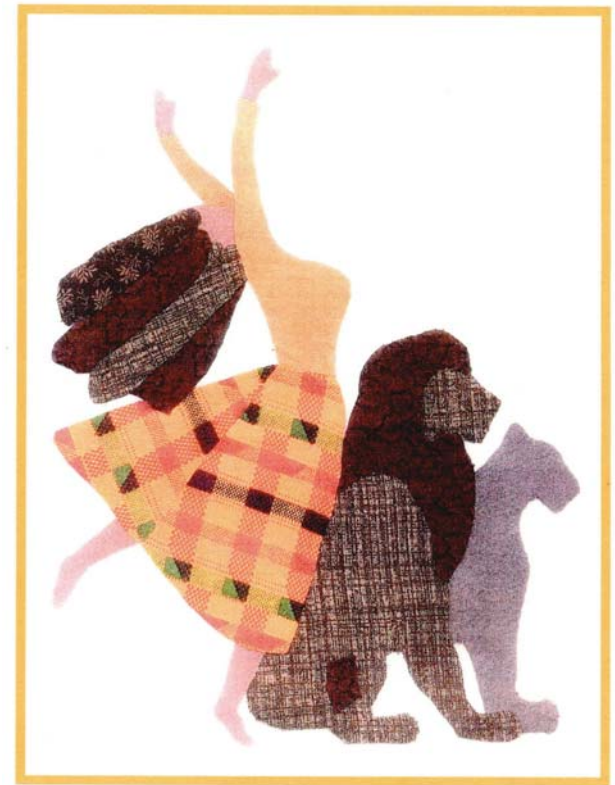

Change doesn't just happen. We make it happen; if we have the right tools.

NTOSAKE is a leadership development program giving women the tools to affect change in their lives, their congregations and their communities

Created and led by women leaders and organizers from across the country, NTOSAKE builds on the community organizing principals taught during the week-long leadership events conducted by the Gamaliel Foundation for all network affiliates.

NTOSAKE is a woman-only event, led by women creating a safe, creative environment that allows women the time and space to learn the essential tools of change:

- Power
- Self-interest
- Money
- Strategic Planning
- Collaboration
- Feminization of the Issues
- Articulating your story
- Creating a local cell
- Public and Private

NTOSAKE is an additional leadership development program offered to women who have attended the Gamaliel weeklong leadership event or plan to attend in the next 12 months.

NTOSAKE is offered in two tracks:

- Track 1: For women who have just come through Gamaliel weeklong training or plan to attend in the next 12 months; for women new to faith based community organizing.
- Track 2: For women who have attended Gamaliel weeklong training and Track 1 NTOSAKE; for women in significant leadership positions in their organizations and/or communities.

All women attend NTOSAKE by invitation, either from an organizer or by a woman leader who has previously attended NTOSAKE.

NTOSAKE is an ever-evolving leadership development experience. In the beginning NTOSAKE was a one track event meant to be extra training for women who needed more time with the leadership concepts first explored in the Gamaliel weeklong event.

The high demand for NTOSAKE has led to expanding NTOSAKE to a leadership development for women offered year round.

These opportunities include issue workshops at the Gamaliel International Leadership Assembly and in collaboration with other women-focused organizations. Hometown cell groups will be offering local opportunities for specialized training, issues development and networking.
